The ITP322 (International Training Programme) on Social Protection for Sustainable Development, implemented by the Swedish International Development Agency (Sida), Arbetsförmedlingen, and the Economic Policy Research Institute (EPRI), aims to strengthen the national social protection systems to address poverty, vulnerability, and inequality while promoting inclusive development. Participants include strategic-level government officials, representatives from ministries and agencies, and professionals from civil society organizations who can drive reforms in their national social protection systems.

Launched in 2019, the programme has trained seven cohorts of participants through an innovative approach that combines theoretical learning with practical implementation. Key features include regional workshops in Africa, training phases in Sweden, and a unique handover mechanism where each cohort builds upon and continues the change programmes initiated by previous groups. The programme combines in-person and online sessions, with country teams implementing medium-term change programmes tailored to their national contexts, supported by international experts and mentors. The programme's extension into a second phase in 2025 continues this vital work through ITP322/8 and ITP322/9, maintaining the momentum of social protection reforms across Ethiopia, Mozambique, Rwanda, Zimbabwe, Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia.

Brief description of change programmes in each country:

- Ethiopia:** Ethiopia's change programme aimed to improve the nutritional status of poor and vulnerable populations through multisectoral efforts for nutrition-sensitive social protection. The programme worked to enhance the Productive Safety Net Programme by integrating health, agriculture, WASH, and education interventions, with a specific focus on addressing malnutrition in children and mothers. The work involved strengthening inter-sectoral coordination, advocating for policy changes, and building the capacity of government institutions to deliver integrated nutrition and social protection services.
- Kenya:** The Kenya Family Resilience Programme aimed to build resilient families in secure environments by supporting households receiving cash transfers. The programme targeted families with children aged 10-18 years through a comprehensive approach combining asset transfers, skills training, mentorship, and referral services. The work involved developing policy frameworks, building evidence for effectiveness, and establishing coordination mechanisms for implementation between national and county governments.
- Mozambique:** Mozambique's change programme sought to reform the country's social protection system's programmatic and institutional framework, with particular emphasis on progressing toward universal child grants and human capital development. The work involved improving coordination between government, donors, and NGOs in implementing child grants, strengthening implementation mechanisms, and developing evidence-based approaches for programme enhancement.
- Rwanda:** Rwanda's change programme focused on designing and establishing a well-coordinated Integrated Case Worker Management System to accelerate human capital development. The work involved streamlining all caseworkers providing social services across health, education, livelihoods, poverty alleviation, gender equality, agriculture, and local government into one integrated structure. This included developing coordination frameworks, training materials, and monitoring systems.

- Tanzania:** Tanzania's change programme aimed to improve nutrition outcomes for under-five children and pregnant/lactating women participating in the Productive Social Safety Net programme. The work involved developing and implementing nutrition-sensitive social protection approaches, including behaviour change communication strategies and establishing monitoring systems to track beneficiaries' access to nutrition services.
- Uganda:** Uganda's integrated change programme aimed to increase social protection coverage along the life cycle for three vulnerable groups: adolescent girls, informal sector workers, and older persons. The work involved policy advocacy, programme design, and implementation support across these three population groups, with an additional focus on shock-responsiveness and disability inclusion in the national social protection system.
- Zambia:** Zambia's change programme focused on implementing the Single Window Initiative, and Cash Plus approaches to enhance social protection service delivery. The work involved creating coordinated entry points for multiple social protection services, strengthening institutional capacities, and developing mechanisms for improved collaboration between government agencies and international partners in implementing social protection programmes.
- Zimbabwe:** Zimbabwe's change programme aimed to develop an efficient, harmonised, and accessible social protection system through three main focus areas: integrated targeting approaches, management information systems, and grievance mechanisms. The work involved developing coordinated systems, strengthening institutional frameworks, and improving service delivery mechanisms across various social protection programmes.
